## Class 1 Partnering with God

God has a plan and purpose for people. As an intercessor it is our responsibility to connect with God through His word in prayer about the strategy to interrupt the devils plan.

## Class 2 The Heart of an Intercessor

Intercession is an act of Love and obedience. One must be willing to examine their own hearts issues and lay side anything that would keep them from being available to intercede on the behalf of another. Psalms 66:18 KJV, Proverbs 4:23

## Class 3 Language of Unity (Intercession)

As an Intercessor we cannot be self-righteous in our prayer language because we are never alone in the business of prayer. We have the power of agreement whether it is from heaven or one another.

Objective: Learner should develop a vocabulary that creates unity during prayer. This invites God and others to come into agreement.
