Warfare on the Mind

The enemy challenged God by means of planting doubt in Eve's mind on what God had said (Genesis 3:1) and when he did Eve began to speak something God had not said and therefore the process of sin began. The battle was over what was spoken by God therefore challenging God himself because "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God (John1:1).
