The Book of Enoch opens by stating it was written to the generation of the Tribulation.

• Has anyone heard about Enoch?

• What do you know about Enoch?

• Why was I interested in Enoch?

• Many of us believe in God (Elohim) and in Jesus (Yeshua) because of faith, which is good. But, what if there was even more evidence that Biblical scripture is true. Would that further increase your faith walk in God and in Jesus (Yeshua)? So when the Bible references the Flood, there were humans living for hundreds of years, and even Giants (Nephilim). What if there was further historical documentation, that could strengthen your faith in God (Elohim)?

Have you heard about the giants that roamed the earth?







Irish Giant

This photo of a 'fossilized Irish giant' was taken at a London rail depot, and appeared in the December 1895 issue of Strand Magazine. The giant was allegedly dug up by a Mr Dyer while prospecting for iron ore in County Antrim (Ireland).

It was 12 ft 2 in (3.71 m) tall, weighed 2 tonnes, and had 6 toes on its right foot. After being exhibited in Dublin, it was brought to England and exhibited in Liverpool and Manchester at sixpence a head, 'attracting scientific men as well as gaping sightseers'. After a legal dispute over ownership, nothing more appears to have been heard or seen of the exhibit.

We can not discuss Giants and all the intricacies before we have biblical background.

Let us take a look at Enoch in the bible.

Enoch is mentioned 12 times in 11 verses in the KJV, including 11 exact phrases shown first.

Gen 4:17

And Cain knew his wife; and she conceived, and bare **Enoch**: and he builded a city, and called the name of the city, after the name of his son, **Enoch**.

Gen 4:18

And unto **Enoch** was born Irad: and Irad begat Mehujael: and Mehujael begat Methusael: and Methusael begat Lamech.

Gen 5:18

And Jared lived an hundred sixty and two years, and he begat **Enoch**:

Gen 5:19

And Jared lived after he begat **Enoch** eight hundred years, and begat sons and daughters:

Gen 5:21

And **Enoch** lived sixty and five years, and begat Methuselah:

Gen 5:22

And **Enoch** walked with God after he begat Methuselah three hundred years, and begat sons and daughters:

Gen 5:23

And all the days of **Enoch** were three hundred sixty and five years:

Gen 5:24

And **Enoch** walked with God: and he was not; for God took him.

Luk 3:37

Which was the son of Mathusala, which was the son of **Enoch**, which was the son of Jared, which was the son of Maleleel, which was the son of Cainan,

Heb 11:5

By faith **Enoch** was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

Jde 1:14

And **Enoch** also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints,


When Enoch had lived 65 years, he became the father of Methuselah. And after he became the father of Methuselah, Enoch walked with God 300 years and had other sons and daughters. Altogether, Enoch lived 365 years. Enoch walked with God; then he was no more, because God took him away.

(Genesis 5:21-24 NIV)

Twice we are told that Enoch walked with God. This reveals that he had a vibrant spiritual life. In fact, God did not allow him to see death. Enoch, along with Elijah, are the only people whom the Bible says never died. Elijah was taken up to heaven in a chariot of fire and Enoch was taken away by the Lord.

The genealogy of Enoch is also cited in First Chronicles:

The descendants of Adam were Seth, Enosh, Kenan, Mahalalel, Jared, Enoch, Methuselah, Lamech. (1 Chronicles 1:1-3 NLT)

He lived in the seventh generation of humanity, or six generations after Adam. We also find that Enoch was an ancestor of Jesus. When Luke recorded the genealogy of Jesus, Enoch is singled out for mention. Luke wrote:

Lamech was the son of Methuselah. Methuselah was the son of Enoch. Enoch was the son of Jared. Jared was the son of Mahalalel. Mahalalel was the son of Kenan. (Luke 3:37 NLT)

Later in the New Testament, we are told that Enoch was called a man who received Gods approval because of his faith. We read about this in the Book of Hebrews. It says:

Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. Indeed, by faith our ancestors received approval.... By faith Enoch was taken so that he did not experience death; and "he was not found, because God had taken him." For it was attested before he was taken away that "he had pleased God." (Hebrews 11:1,25 NRSV)

Here we are told that Enoch pleased God by his faithfulness.

Jude Cites Enoch We then come to a statement made by Enoch which is recorded by the New Testament writer, Jude, but is not recorded in the Old Testament. Jude cited the following statement of Enoch:

Now Enoch, the seventh in descent, beginning with Adam, even prophesied of them, saying, "Look! The Lord is coming with thousands and thousands of his holy ones, to execute judgment on all, and to convict every person of all their thoroughly ungodly deeds that they have committed, and of all the harsh words that ungodly sinners have spoken against him." (Jude 14,15 NET)

Enoch named his firstborn son Methuselah (Genesis 5:22). The name Methuselah is made up of two Hebrew words; "meth" meaning "death" and "selah" meaning "to send." The way Genesis 5:22 puts these two words together is unique. The spelling suggests the name can be translated as a Hebrew sentence meaning "when he is dead, it will be sent." If we add the years from creation to the birth of Methuselah as found in Genesis 5, and then add his age at death, we find he died the very same year the Flood came. If we look in the ancient book of Jasher 5:36, we see Methuselah died exactly one week before the Flood occurred. This is the same day Noah entered the Ark! (Genesis 7:1-4).

The timing clearly shows Enoch knew of the prophecy of God's judgment of

the world and, apparently, God gave Enoch a prophecy that the day his son

died would be the end of the world as he knew it! This would, indeed, keep

Enoch centered on both his son and the teachings of God throughout his

whole life, walking very closely with God.

By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not

found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had

this testimony, that he pleased God. But without faith it is impossible to

please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that

He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.

Hebrews 11:5-6

Theologian John Gill (AD 1697-1771) wrote about the Book of Enoch saying:

"Enoch, the seventh from Adam, delivered out the prophecy referred to by the apostle Jude, (verses 14, 15) ... the Jews make mention of a writing of his in their ancient book of Zohar; and in the Targum of Jonathan on Genesis 5:24, he is called the great scribe; and several of the Christian fathers speak of his book as authentic, as Tertullian and others; and the Arabic writers [Flavius Josephus] tell us of pyramids and pillars erected by him, on which he engraved the arts and the instruments of them; and some writers ascribe the invention of letters and writing of books to him" A Dissertation Concerning the Antiquity of the Hebrew Language, Letters, Vowel Points, and Accents, by John Gill, D.D., ch. 2, pg. 36

The Book of Enoch was written anytime between 2800-200 BC If the legends are to be believed, Enoch passed his book and other books to Noah, who preserved them in the Ark. Noah then passed Enoch's book on to Shem, who preserved it in the city of Salem. Eventually it was passed down to the Israeli tribe of Levi for safe keeping. Somewhere along the line a new Hebrew translation renamed some of the place names of the cities, rivers, and lands. This was most likely done around the time of Solomon. It was then preserved up to the time the Essenes buried it, along with other ancient texts, to be found among the Dead Sea Scrolls.

The Book of Enoch was not received by some Christians because it was not part of the Jewish canon. The Jews [Pharisees] rejected it, like some portions of Scripture, because it testified of Christ. Its quotation from the epistle of Jude proves it is to be considered genuine prophecy.

In AD 1768-1948 A man named James Bruce heard that the only translation known to still exist

of the lost Book of Enoch was preserved by the Ethiopian Christian Church.

In AD 1768, Bruce travelled to Ethiopia to find the Book of Enoch. Six years

later, in 1773, he brought three manuscripts back to London where they lay in

the British Museum untranslated. One hundred and twenty years later, in 1893, a man named R. H. Charles translated the manuscripts from the Ethiopic language into English.

IMPORTANT:

Enoch Should Not Be Placed in the Scripture

The Book of Enoch teaches that the righteous are to live their lives by a series of books that will be given to them. Further, they will be judged by these books, not the Book of Enoch (104). Now we know this to be true; Christians are judged by the sixty-six books of the Bible. Because of the way Enoch states this, it is obvious that the Book of Enoch was not supposed to be placed into the canon of Scripture but kept as a special message to those who lived in the generation just prior to the Tribulation period.

We have a translation of the real Book of Enoch which has been edited from time to time. The style of writing suggests this translation of Enoch was done about 2000 BC and possibly again in 200 BC. If we find that it contains accurate prophecy, we must see it as a true gift from God. Look at these charts below to see Enoch's doctrines and prophecies and how they line up with Scripture.
