1. Why we read the Bible? It is the BOOK OF ALL BOOKS

“Before there were books, there were words.”

It is the **BOOK OF ALL BOOKS**-it answers all of life's questions, gives sustenance to a hungry soul, quench's the thirst of the dry mouth, satisfies the philosopher, challenges the skeptic, conquers the rebellious, gives sight and insight to the seeking, to the gossiper it has plenty of good stories to gossip about, to the king it administers the rule and reign of his position, and saves the dying soul. In short; the word of God is quick (alive), and powerful (active), and sharper than any twoedged (double-edge) sword, piercing (penetrating) even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner (judge) of the thoughts and intents (attitudes) of the heart (Hebrews 4:12 KJV, NIV).

2. In what way is it unique?

You are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men (2 Corinthians 3:2)

2. The Bible is unique first in that God wanted the words spoken to be written in a book.

HOLY BIBLE

First, Author is GOD and it has a marvelous continuity of any book and without error that has ever been written. The Bible declares 2500 times “God said....the Lord has said...thus saith the Lord,” etc.

Secondly, God used man to write down the inspired words given to him; each writer expressed his own feelings in his own way in his generation. Each writer was human and made mistakes none of their mistakes got in the way of what they were writing. You see, it is a human book and yet it is a God-Book.

Third, Moses was told to write the words in a book (of the law) until he was finished (Deuteronomy 31:24).

Joshua wrote in a book, called “the book of the law” Joshua 24:26

Jeremiah was told to write all the words he was hearing in a book (Jeremiah 30:2)

Finally, it was written by men of all walks of life, prince and pauper, the highly intellectual and the very simple.

It is God’s communication to man.
